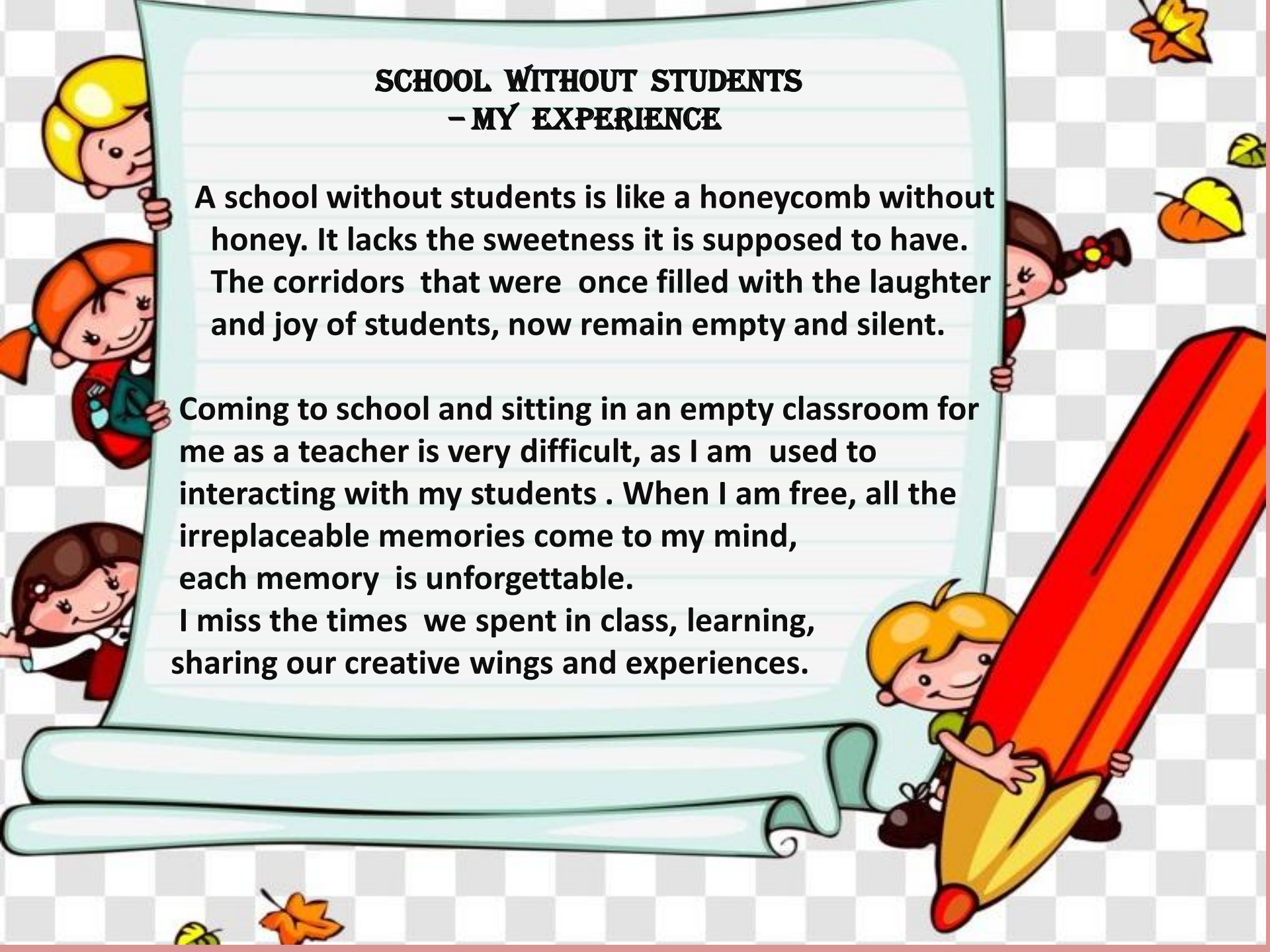



## **SCHOOL WITHOUT STUDENTS - MY EXPERIENCE**

## कोविड-19 संकट में गणेश चतुर्थी उत्सव

गणेश चतुर्थी को विनायका चतुर्थी के नाम से भी जाना जाता है, जो पूरे भारत में मनाए जाने वाले महत्वपूर्ण हिंदू त्योहारों में से एक है। इस दिन को भगवान गणेश



के जन्मदिन के रूप में मनाया जाता है, भगवान गणेश भगवान शिव और देवी पार्वती के पुत्र हैं। स्वामी गणेश बुद्धि, समृद्धि और सौभाग्य के प्रतीक है। गणेश चतुर्थी को हिंदू महीने के शुक्ल की पष्ठी को मनाया जाता है (आमतौर पर अगस्त और सितंबर के बीच पड़ता है) यह त्योहार हिंदूओं द्वारा बड़े उत्साह के साथ मनाया जाता है। लोग भगवान गणेश की मूर्तियों को अपने घरों में लाते हैं और पूजा करते हैं। स्थान और परंपरा के आधार पर इस त्योहार की अवधि 1 से 11 दिनों तक मनाया जाता है। उत्सव के अंतिम के दिन मूर्तियों को रंगीन और संगीतमय जुलूस में निकाला जाता है और पारंपरिक रूप से पानी में डुबोया जाता है।

कोरोनावायरस महामारी के कारण इस साल, दुनिया भर में लोग सामूहिक रूप से या सार्वजनिक रूप से किसी भी त्योहार

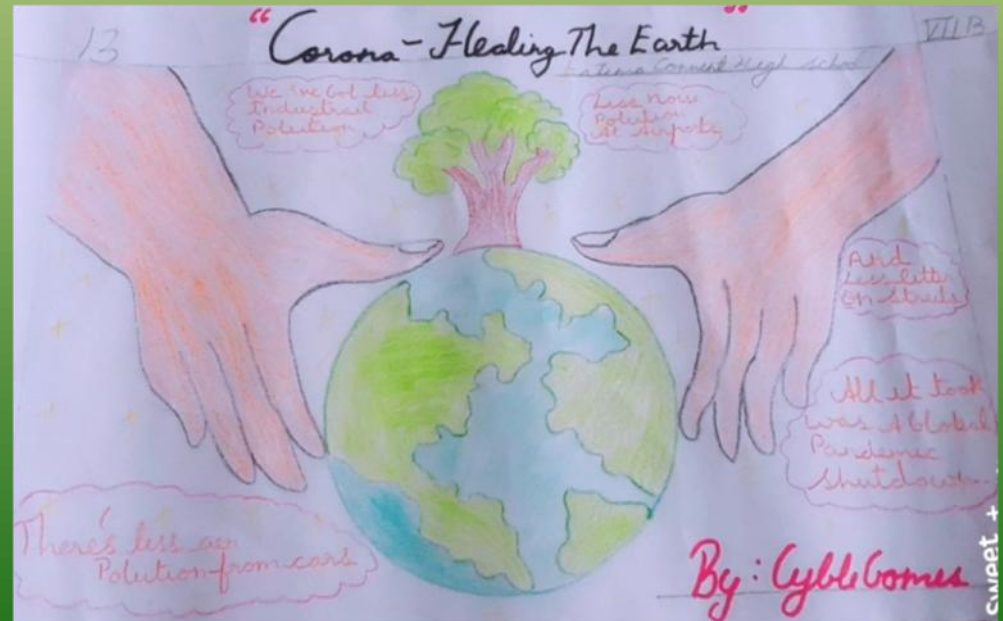
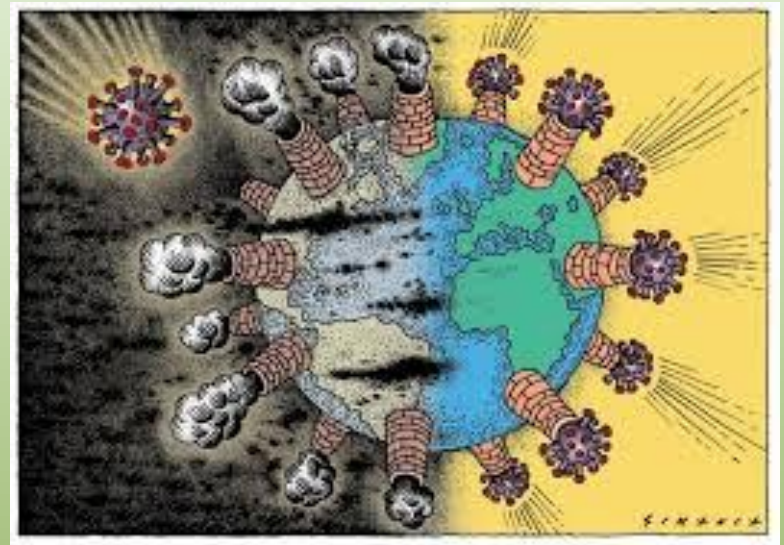
को नहीं मना पाए हैं। इसी कारण गणेश चतुर्थी भी कम धूमधाम से मनायी गयी। लोगों ने बीमारी के प्रसार को रोकने के लिए खुद को सीमित कर लिया था। गणेशोत्सव के आयोजक सरकार के दिशानिर्देशों का पालन करने के लिए सख्त प्रोटोकॉल का पालन किया। इसलिए इस वर्ष के गणेश चतुर्थी उत्सव में भगवान गणेश की विशाल मूर्तियों की झलक पाने के लिए पंडालों को झुकाते हुए मानवता का एक सागर नहीं दिखाई दिया। इस साल गणेश मूर्ति का आकार घटाकर 4 फीट कर दिया गया था कोरोना महामारी के कारण गणेश उत्सव 11 दिन से घटाकर डेढ़ दिन का कर दिया गया। लोगों ने घरों में पंडितों को न बुलाकर स्वयं ही पूजा करने का निश्चय किया। सभी लोगों ने एक दूसरे के घर ना जाते हुए अपने घरों में ही भजन-आरती की और त्योहार मनाया।

इस साल सार्वजनिक गणेश उत्सव भी कम उत्साह में मनाया गया। सार्वजनिक गणेश उत्सव जो 11 दिन मनाया जाता था वह घटाकर डेढ़ दिन का कर दिया गया। पंडाल को भी कम सजाया गया और मूर्ति को छोटा कर दिया गया था। पंडाल में ज्यादा भीड़ भाड़ ना हो इसलिए कोई जुलूस या कार्यक्रम नहीं रखा गया। आमतौर पर लालबागचा राजा की मूर्ति लगभग 18-20 फीट लंबी होती है लेकिन 2020 में आकार 4 फीट

तक कम हो गया। पंडाल में ज्यादा भीड़ न हो इसलिए ऑनलाइन दर्शन और आरती का आयोजन भी किया गया था। इस साल गणपति विसर्जन भी साधारण रूप से मनाया गया। धोल ताशों के साथ जुलूस भी नहीं निकाला गया। विसर्जन को सुचारू रूप से चलाने के लिए कृत्रिम तालाब और टैंक भी बनाए गए थे। कोरोना महामारी के कारण लोगों ने गणेश उत्सव बहुत ही सादगी से ज्यादा भीड़ भाड़ न करके अपने घरों में ही मनाया।



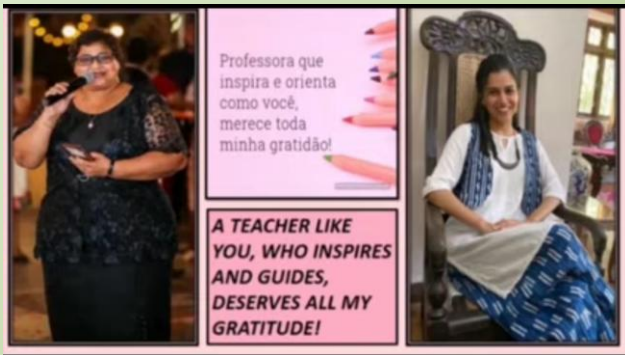

**"Yes" the man nodded.**

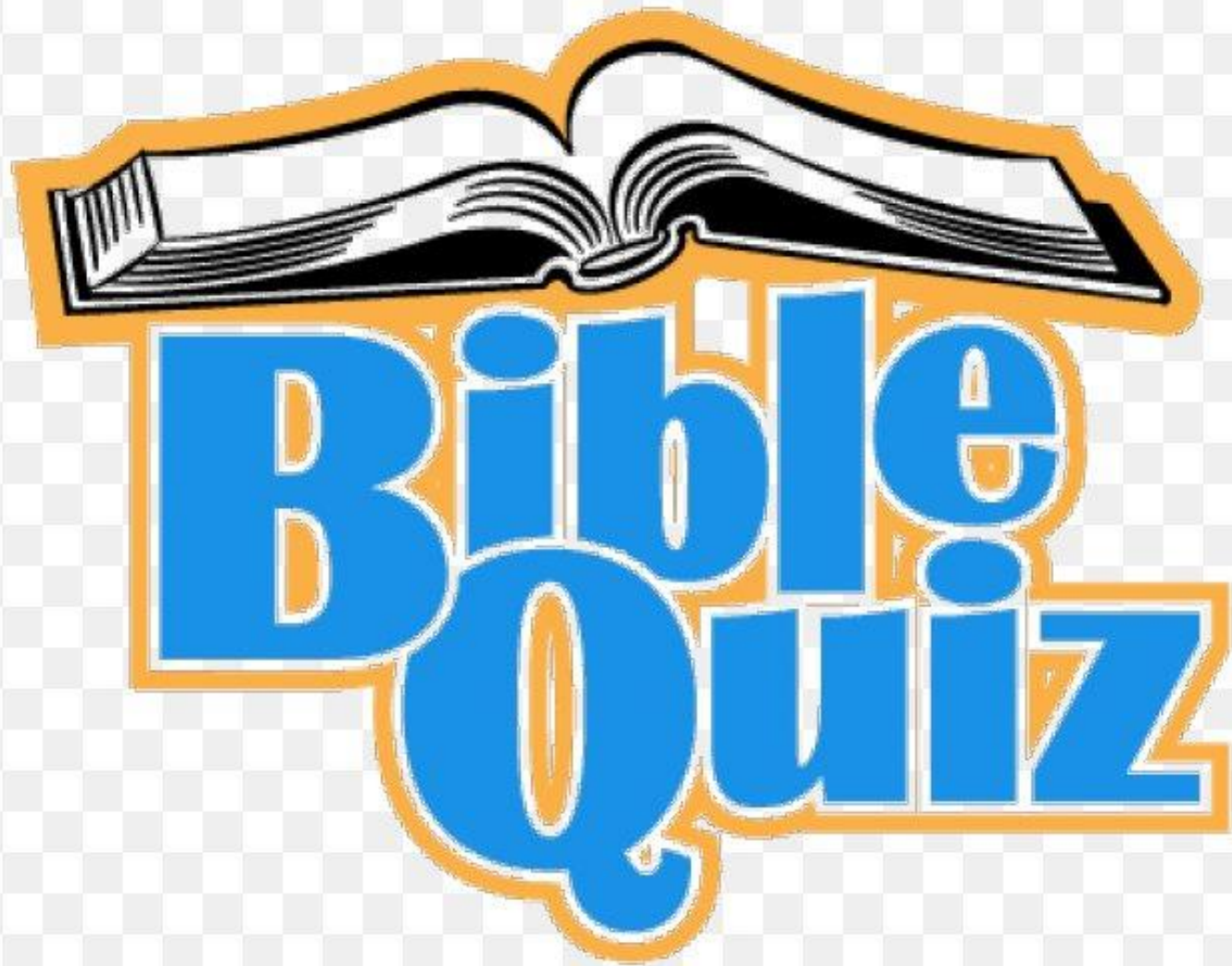
